

Illness Policy

Parents must inform the Center if their child or any member of the household contacts a communicable disease or parasitic condition such as Pertussis, German or Regular Measles, Mumps, Chicken Pox, Diphtheria, Pinworms, or Scarlet Fever. If your child does contract any of the above, please keep them at home and report their condition to the Center immediately.

These types of illnesses have specific recommendations from the Fairfax County Health Department for exclusion that we must follow. Notices to other families will be posted in each classroom of possible exposure to communicable illnesses. Children should not return to the Center until they no longer meet the criteria for exclusion as described.

In addition, your child must be kept home if they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- A temperature over 100° (orally)
- Intestinal disturbance accompanied by diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Any undiagnosed rash
- Sore or discharging eyes or ears or profuse nasal discharge

Do not bring your child in if he/she exhibits any of the above symptoms. If he/she develops any of the above symptoms at school, we will isolate them and ask you to come within one hour to take him/her home. Please note, tuition will not be refunded for those days that your child is unable to attend school due to illness. **Your cooperation is very much appreciated.**
